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- Recommendations for leveraging campus-specific services, such as disability support, writing centers, mentorship programs, and the career center
- Internship and resume-building opportunities starting as early as sophomore year
- Pre-semester and mid-semester checklists, plus exam planning and post-semester reflection
- Strategies for navigating institutional policies (withdrawals, pass/fail, GPA impact, academic probation, and appeals)
- Graduation tracking and long-term planning (minors, concentrations, honors programs, and graduate school prep)
